“Hang Tung” – REACH’s Chinese trade name

REACH GLOBAL SERVICES LIMITED today announces that “恆通” (“Hang Tung”, which means “Everlasting communications” in English) has been adopted as the trade name as well as the abbreviation of the Chinese name of REACH. This trade name is applicable from now onwards in Mainland China, Hong Kong and Taiwan.

REACH is a 50-50 joint venture between Hong Kong-based PCCW and Australia’s Telstra Corporation Ltd. It is Asia’s largest international carrier of combined voice, private line and IP data services. It is also one of the world's top ten carriers of international voice traffic.

REACH’s products and services include an extensive portfolio of voice, data, IP and satellite connectivity. The company has interests in more than 50 submarine cable and satellite systems (including the largest satellite teleport in Asia), and landing rights and operating licences in most major markets including Hong Kong, Japan, Singapore, Australia, North America and Europe.
